# **Project NISHAD – Strengthening Social Organizations**

#### 1) Sondara Gurukulam (Beed):

Beneficiary staff – 22

Beneficiary students – 200

**Training days - 10** 

This residential school is situated in Domari village, in a hilly area near Beed. Initiated for children of sugarcane laborers in that area, this school aims for the development of the Marathwada region.

In this quarter VOPA mainly assisted them in strategic planning of the works and projects in the coming year. The school syllabus, timetable, hierarchies, reporting structures, documentation methods, annual goals, assessment indicators, checklists, individual workplans, accounting protocols, etc. were discussed and adopted in depth. We also conducted sessions for attitude and team building, gender sensitization, etc.
